Provide **client centred-care** and advice during pregnancy, labour, birth and postpartum for the birthing person and baby



Provide education, health promotion and informed choice



Deliver care in a **variety of settings** including hospitals,
clinics, birth centres, homes and
other locations



Prescribe, order and administer **pharmacologic agents**



Order, perform and interpret results of screening and diagnostic tests



Identify abnormal conditions, recommend and initiate treatment, and make referrals if needed



Assess need for pain relief during labour and intervene using non-pharmacological and pharmacological measures



Counsel on **vaccinations** and administer certain **vaccinations**



Prevent, recognize and manage obstetrical emergencies



Counsel on benefits of **breastfeeding**; encourage and assist with initiation



Provide ongoing **newborn care and assessment** of well being
and development



Counsel on human sexuality, fertility and contraception



Collaborate with other health care professionals, facilitate referral and consult when appropriate



Provide well-client care for at least six weeks post-partum
